FOR HANDLING WASTE CONTAINERS AND BAGS - MEDULIN

 <p>MIXED WASTE CONTAINERS GREEN 4-WHEEL BINS GREEN 2-WHEEL BINS</p>	<p>USE THE MIXED WASTE CONTAINERS TO DISPOSE: residual waste without useful or hazardous properties and in particular: soiled food packaging, soiled paper and foil for wrapping food; soiled paper towels and handkerchiefs, razor blades, pads, cotton products, vacuum cleaner bags, sweepings, cigarette stubs, nappies for children and adults, etc.</p>	<p>PLEASE DO NOT USE THE MIXED WASTE CONTAINERS TO DISPOSE: waste whose useful properties can be reused and recycled, such as liquid waste, embers, carcasses, electrical and electronic waste, batteries, hazardous waste.</p>	<p>DISPOSE of waste so as to minimize its volume and not to stain the disposing container.</p>
 <p>PAPER AND CARDBOARD WASTE CONTAINERS BLUE 4-WHEEL BINS BLUE 2-WHEEL BINS</p>	<p>USE THE BLUE PAPER AND CARDBOARD WASTE CONTAINERS TO DISPOSE: newspapers, office paper, magazines, catalogues, brochures, note pads, paper and cardboard packaging.</p>	<p>PLEASE DO NOT USE THE BLUE CONTAINERS TO DISPOSE: Tetrapak packaging, plasticized paper, metalized paper, oiled paper, photographs.</p>	<p>DISPOSE of paper and cardboard waste so as to minimize volume. Remember to separate cardboard food and medicines packaging as well as containers for cookies and other sweets.</p>
 <p>YELLOW BAGS FOR PLASTIC WASTE</p>	<p>USE YELLOW BAGS TO DISPOSE: food and drink packaging, shampoo and detergent containers, and plastic bags.</p>	<p>PLEASE DO NOT USE THE YELLOW BAGS TO DISPOSE: cellophane paper, packaging for chemicals and inflammable substances, plastic toys.</p>	<p>Before DISPOSING it is desirable to rinse plastic bottles and other packaging as well as to remove the caps. Avoid buying plastic bags, use linen bags instead.</p>
 <p>BLACK BAGS FOR METAL WASTE</p>	<p>USE BLACK BAGS TO DISPOSE: tin, cans, metallic lids and similar.</p>	<p>PLEASE DO NOT USE THE BLACK BAGS TO DISPOSE: spray containers, packaging for chemicals and inflammable substances.</p>	<p>Before DISPOSING please remove food rests. Aluminium foil, aluminium trays and similar can be disposed of.</p>
 <p>GREEN BAGS FOR GLASS WASTE</p>	<p>USE GREEN BAGS TO DISPOSE: glass bottles, glass jars and glassware.</p>	<p>PLEASE DO NOT USE THE GREEN BAGS TO DISPOSE: containers of chemicals and inflammable substances, refractory glass, flat glass, crystal glass, mirrors, porcelain, ceramics, light bulbs, neon lamps.</p>	<p>Before DISPOSING metal lids and caps should be removed, while the printed labels on the packaging can be left. If possible, glass jars and bottles should be rinsed and cleaned with water to avoid unpleasant smells from leftovers.</p>

Single types of waste are collected according to a waste collection schedule as indicated on the back of this page, provided that waste containers/bags are available for collection by waste collection trucks, that are placed at the designated collection spot by 7 AM on the collection day.

Note: If the waste is not separated correctly in the respective separate collection bag/container or if it is dirty, it will not be collected.
